Residential Development by number of units and by business unit	4



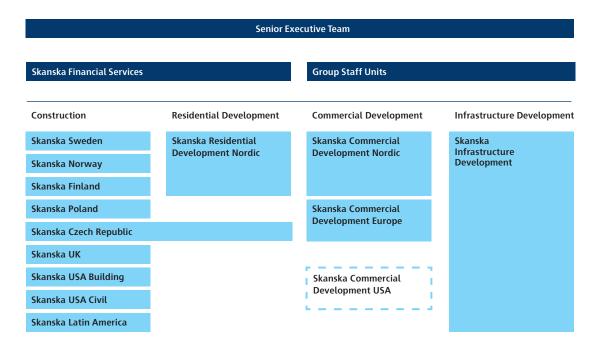

Residential development projects occur only in some markets where Skanska has a permanent presence: Sweden, Norway, Denmark, Finland and the Czech Republic. Finnish operations also include residential development in Estonia.

The Nordic housing markets have great similarities and are thus combined in one unit – Skanska Residential Development Nordic (Skanska RD Nordic).

Markets

At the end of 2009, there were about 2,236 residential units under construction. Of these,74 percent were sold. The number of completed unsold units totaled fewer than 484, most of them in Finland (incl. Estonia). During the year, construction started on about 685 units. In the Nordic countries, the number of residen-

tial units started was 564, while in the Czech Republic (incl. Slovakia) they totaled more than 121. The number of residential units sold during the year was 2,277 of which 2,008 in the Nordic countries and 269 in the Czech Republic.
