At the end of 2010, there were about 4,534 homes under construction. Of these, 59 percent were sold. The number of completed unsold homes totaled fewer than 177, most of them in Czech Republic. During the year, construction started on about 4,113 homes. In

the Nordic countries, the number of homes started was 3,698, while in the Czech Republic they totaled more than 415. The number of homes sold during the year was 3,176 of which 2,761 in the Nordic countries and 415 in the Czech Republic.
